

ABSTRAK

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GAMBARAN PEMELIHARAAN DAN PENGENDALIAN PENCEGAHAN INFEKSI REKAM MEDIS COVID-19 OLEH PETUGAS REKAM MEDIS DI RSD IDAMAN BANJARBARU TAHUN 2021

Virus corona dapat bertahan antara empat sampai lima hari di berbagai benda yang berbau seperti aluminium, kayu, kertas, plastik dan kaca. Penyebarannya melalui media kertas, khususnya dokumen rekam medis tentunya tetap berisiko untuk terjadi. Pemeliharaan rekam medis COVID-19 belum dilaksanakan sesuai edaran pormiki dimana tidak dimasukkan ke dalam plastik, tidak dimasukkan ke dalam *box container*, dan disimpan ditempat khusus. Tujuan penelitian ini mengetahui gambaran pemeliharaan dan pengendalian pencegahan infeksi COVID-19 oleh petugas rekam medis tahun 2021. Metode penelitian menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif dengan subjek penelitian informan utama yaitu petugas koding dan informan triangulasi yaitu kepala instalasi rekam medis dan petugas administrasi ruang isolasi. Instrumen penelitian ini yaitu pedoman observasi dan pedoman wawancara, teknik analisis data penelitian ini yaitu deskriptif dengan proses pengumpulan data, reduksi data, penyajian data, serta penarikan kesimpulan dan verifikasi. Dari hasil penelitian ini, bahwa SPO (Standar Prosedur Operasional) pemeliharaan rekam medis COVID-19 di RSD Idaman Banjarbaru belum tersedia, dalam upaya pengendalian dan pencegahan infeksi di UKRM RSD Idaman Banjarbaru petugas mematuhi seperti menggunakan masker saat di lingkungan kerja, mencuci tangan dengan rutin menggunakan handrub, membersihkan meja maupun permukaan datar lainnya sebelum dan sesudah bekerja, meminimalisir kontak pasien atau keluarga pasien dengan berkas rekam medis, dan pemeliharaan rekam medis pasien COVID-19 oleh petugas rekam medis beberapa prosedur tidak dilaksanakan seperti tidak dimasukkan ke dalam plastik kuning, tidak dimasukkan ke dalam box container, serta tidak diletakkan di tempat khusus. Sebaiknya rumah sakit membuat standar operasional prosedur (SOP) khusus mengenai pemeliharaan rekam medis pasien COVID-19 agar petugas mematuhi dan mengantisipasi potensi petugas tertular virus COVID-19.

ABSTRACT

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OVERVIEW OF THE MAINTENANCE AND CONTROL OF MEDICAL RECORD INFECTION PREVENTION BY MEDICAL RECORDING OFFICERS AT RSD IDAMAN BANJARBARU YEAR 2021

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The corona virus can last between four and five days in various objects made of such as aluminum, wood, paper, plastic and glass. Its spread through paper media, especially medical record documents, is of course still a risk to occur. Maintenance of COVID-19 medical records has not been carried out according to a pormiki distribution, which is not put in plastic, not put in a container, and stored in a special place. The purpose of this study is to determine the description of the maintenance and control of COVID-19 infection prevention by medical record officers in 2021. The research method used a qualitative descriptive method with the main informant research subject, namely coding officers and triangulation informants, namely the head of the medical record installation and the isolation room administration officer. The research instruments were observation guidelines and interview guidelines. The data analysis technique for this research was descriptive with the process of data collection, data reduction, display data, as well as drawing conclusions and verification. From the results of this study, that the SPO (Standard Operational Procedure) maintenance of COVID-19 medical records at RSD Idaman Banjarbaru was not yet available, in an effort to control and prevent infection at UKRM RSD Idaman Banjarbaru officers obeyed such as wearing masks when in the work environment, washing hands routinely. using handrub, cleaning tables or other flat surfaces before and after work, minimizing contact with patients or their families with medical record files, and maintaining medical records of COVID-19 patients by medical record officers, some procedures are not carried out such as not being put in yellow plastic, no put in a container box, and not placed in a special place. The hospital should make a special standard operating procedure (SOP) regarding the maintenance of medical records for COVID-19 patients so that officers comply with and anticipate the potential for workers to contract the COVID-19 virus.
